Frequently Asked Questions

Who is eligible?

Eligibility includes homeowners policies and farm policies with an owner-occupied dwelling.

Will participation in the Ting program affect my coverage or premiums?

No, participation in the Ting program will not affect your coverage, premium, or eligibility for discounts.

How easy is it to install Ting?

It is very simple! All you'll need is an open outlet, Wi-Fi signal, and smartphone. The Ting app will guide you through the setup process, which typically only takes two minutes.

What does the \$1,000 Ting service credit cover?

The \$1,000 credit can only be applied toward the labor required for the mitigation of an electrical fire hazard identified by Ting. This credit cannot be used for general electrical work that you would like to have completed in your home.

What happens after the third year of service?

Prior to the end of the initial three-year period, Westfield will communicate any potential program updates. There is no obligation to continue the service.

What does the Ting Sensor monitor?

Ting helps monitor your electrical system and the items plugged into it. It is looking for the main precursors to electrical fires, such as micro-arcs, loose connections, and faulty appliances or devices. These signals usually develop over time, so Ting is designed to provide you with advanced warnings to address these hazards before they develop into an electrical fire. Ting does not contain any other technology, such as microphones, cameras, or motion detectors.

What Ting data is shared with Westfield?

Only electrical events detected by your Ting sensor are shared with Westfield. If a fire hazard is identified, a summary of the hazard is shared with us.
